Community Safety Surveillance Camera Installation

Introduction and Scope:

The Township of Sioux Narrows – Nestor Falls is seeking proposals from qualified firms for the installation of Community Safety Surveillance Cameras to monitor five remote areas in the community including:

- the Sioux Narrows Helipad
- The Nestor Falls Cemetery
- Red Pine Trail Head
- the Nestor Falls Airstrip
- Bass Lake Park.

Project Background:

All of these areas within the community and public spaces and for the use and enjoyment of all community members. They are currently unmonitored and are realizing increased instances of vandalism, misuse, and damage, which is posing a danger to public safety and limiting the enjoyable use of these public spaces. The intention is that the installation of cameras will help to protect municipal property and ensure its continued safe and enjoyable use by all members of the community.

The Cameras need to be able to operate and capture footage in remote areas.

The capture and storage of video surveillance must be implemented in a privacy protective manner, and follow FIPPA and MFIPPA regulations, with the capacity to store data for 30 days and then securely destroy it afterwards. Access to video captured must be limited and follow municipal regulations.

Proposal Submission Requirements:

Interested firms are invited to prepare a detailed proposal which clearly indicates how the work will be carried out and detail how site surveillance will be carried out while protecting privacy.

Firms may arrange to visit the sites prior to submission of a proposal.

All interested firms must submit one electronic copy of their proposal.

All proposals must be submitted by 4:00 p.m., **Friday, May 1, 2026**
