2026 Landfill Permits

All residents are required to have a 2026 Landfill Permit prior to entering the Landfill.

Permits can be picked up at the Nestor Falls Municipal Office on Thursdays between 9:00 am—4:00 pm or at the Sioux Narrows Municipal Office Mondays—Friday from 8:00 am—4:00 pm.

There is no charge for these permits.

Red Pine Trail—Safety Update for Snowmobilers

Please remember that snowmobiles are not allowed on the walking and bike trails.

To keep riders safe, snowmobile signage will be added as soon as possible to guide travel around the outside of the trails and toward the lake lookout. The bike skills park contains snow-covered features that can be difficult to see in winter. Please follow the perimeter loop for a safer ride.
