Landfill Summer Hours May 1st—September 30th Open 5 Days Per Week

Closed Mondays and Tuesdays (unless otherwise posted)

Sioux Narrows: 8:00 am—11:30 pm
Nestor Falls: 1:00 am—4:30 pm

Residents are required to have a Landfill Permit which can be obtained at the Municipal Office during business hours. There is no fee for this permit.

Construction waste, debris, rubble, including excavation waste will require the purchase of a separate Landfill Permit prior to entering the Landfill.

2026 Landfill Fees:

- Per one tonne stake truck \$42.00 per load, plus HST
- Per three tonne stake truck \$102.00 per load, plus HST
- Per dump trailer (12' and under) \$110.00 per load, plus HST
- Per dump trailer (over 12') \$160.00 per load, plus HST
- Per tandem truck (14 yards) \$300.00 per load, plus HST
- Per Packer (25 yards) \$408.00 per load, plus HST
- Per Packer (40 yards) \$480.00 per load, plus HST
- Fibreglass Boats (per foot) \$5.00 per foot, plus HST
- Commercial garbage collection service \$40.00 per tonne, plus HST
- Untagged refrigeration units of any kind \$75.00 per unit, plus HST
- Mattresses and Hide-A-Beds \$20.00 per item, plus HST

Water Testing: A water testing drop-off services facilitated by the Northwestern Health Unit will be available from May to September at the Sioux Narrows Health Hub. Public Health Ontario now offers a secure **Online Water Testing Portal** for private well water testing. Paper forms are no longer used for submitting private water samples.

How it works:

1. Collect your sample using a PHO bottle available at the Health Hub
2. Submit your information online: [Online Water Testing Portal/Public Health Ontario](#)
3. Drop off your sample at the Health Hub by 11:30 am on the first and third Tuesday of the month, May—September
4. Get results in 2-4 business days (download from PHO online portal or call 1-877-723-3426 for results)

Small Drinking Water System (SDWS) testing forms are the same as before. Samples can be dropped off at the Health Hub by 11:30 am the first and third Tuesday of the month, May—September.
