Window Replacement at the Northern Ontario Sport Fishing Centre

Introduction and Scope:

The Township of Sioux Narrows – Nestor Falls is seeking proposals from qualified firms for the replacement of 5 broken exterior windows at the Northern Ontario Sport Fishing Centre.

The Northern Ontario Sport Fishing Centre is a signature building in the heart of Sioux Narrows. Its exterior is comprised of glass windows on 2 full sides of the building.



Project Background:

Over the past 2 years 5 exterior windowpanes have broken as a result of projectiles resulting in the shattering of the exterior pane of glass. These windows are not standard size and specialized skills and expertise are required to replace them.

The Township is seeking qualified professional glass installers to evaluate the existing windows and provide a proposal including cost and workplan to replace the broken panes.

Proposal Submission Requirements:

Interested firms are invited to prepare a detailed proposal which clearly indicates how the work will be carried out and detail the costs for the replacement program.

Firms must arrange to visit the sites prior to submission of a proposal.

All interested firms must submit one electronic copy of their proposal.

All proposals must be submitted by 4:00p.m. on **Thursday July 16th, 2026**
