10-DIGIT DIALING

On **January 15, 2024 10-digit dialing will be mandatory**: residents and businesses need to dial the area code followed by the 7-digit number for all local calls. If the 10-digit number is not dialed, the call will not be completed. **How to prepare for 10-digit dialing**

Residents will need to add their area code to programmed numbers in all of their communications devices and equipment (including phones, auto dialers, computers and lifeline equipment) and verify that their alarm systems are compatible with local 10-digit dialing.
