Kakagi Lake (Crow Lake)


Total Distance: 25 km

Kakagi Lake - 25km Route With Great Campsite. Wind can pick up and easy to be wind bound. Best is 3 Days 2 Nights to enjoy and explore although could be done as a 2 day 1 night with great weather. Grade would be expert with winds or moderate in the right conditions.

2	49.25794, -93.94851	▲	Possible camp site	2-3 canoe campsite, nice and sheltered
3	49.26733, -93.95778	▲	Possible camp site	Group Site, good for 6-7 canoes/ basecamp good swimming. Nice cliffs near by, nice spot with great shelter. This is the preferred and best site on the route.
4	49.26392, -93.95425	▲	Possible camp site	Small campsite, 2-3 canoes, faces NE
5	49.27322, -93.9382	▲	Possible camp site	Larger site, good for 3-5 canoes, sheltered well with good swimming
6	49.29693, -93.91048	▲	Possible camp site	Small site, 2-3 canoes, SW exposure
7	49.30984, -93.89022	▲	Possible camp site	Sheltered, good for 2-3 canoes. Close to portage/dam into Ceder Tree Lake. This route can be built to include portages and other lakes.
8	49.20591, -93.93655	▲	Possible camp site	Nice spot, good for 3-4 canoes, good picnic area. SE Exposure.
9	49.232, -93.92696	▲	Possible camp site	Small site 2-3 canoes, NE exposure. Other areas to explore if good weather.
