Total Days: 3

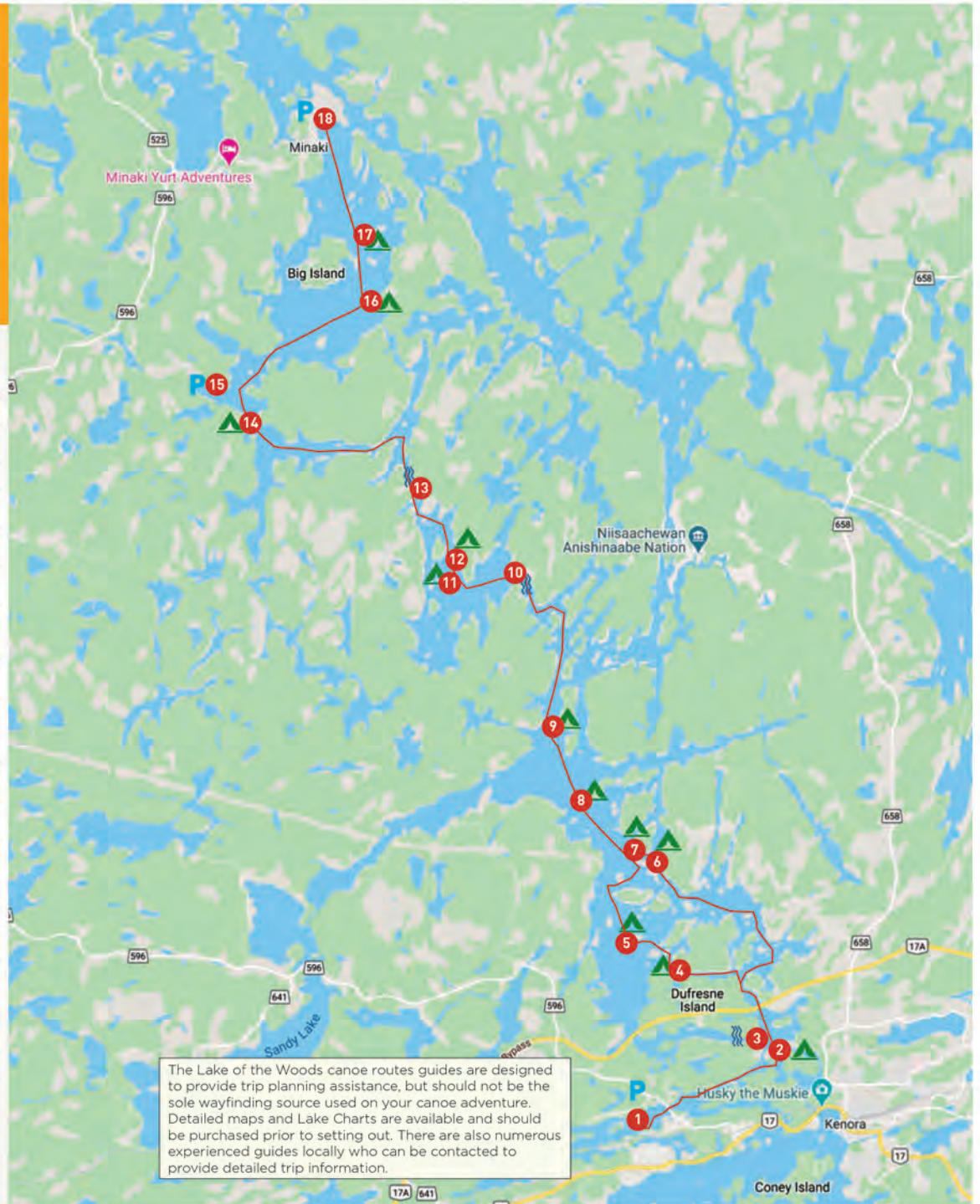

Total Distance is 40 km if done Keewatin to Minaki, 3 days 2 nights, difficulty moderate. Total Distance is 24km if done in a loop. 2 days 1 night, difficulty is moderate.
