In Touch Lock It or Lose It

A professional can steal your vehicle in just 30 seconds. A vehicle with an unlocked door or an open window is an easy target. Protect your vehicle from theft.

- ◇ Always roll up your vehicle's windows, lock the doors and pocket the keys when you park your car.
- ◇ Park in a well-lit area and never leave valuables in plain view.
- ◇ Never leave your vehicle unattended while it is running.
- ◇ If you have a garage, use it and lock the door as well as your vehicle.
- ◇ Never leave your car keys in plain view or in an easily accessible area.
- ◇ Keep your vehicle registration certificate and proof of insurance on you at all times. Don't leave these documents in your glove box.
- ◇ Put valuable objects or packages in the trunk.

Inform police at 1-888-310-1122 if you see vehicles or vehicle-related activities that look suspicious.

Municipal Musings

Infrastructure/Asset Management Plan. What does that mean? It is a living document that includes all of our infrastructure and equipment. The plan includes inventory, values, life expectancies and future estimated replacement costs and/or repairs. For example, a fire truck may require replacement after 20 years and could cost between \$200,000 and \$300,000 at that time. As well, buildings require on-going maintenance, such as new roofing after fifteen years. There is also cemetery maintenance, road brushing and culverts, road resurfacing, signs, lights, computers, trucks and equipment, docks, landfills, etc. Ongoing maintenance costs are part of our annual operating budget and large, one-time expenditures are part of our capital budget. The Asset Management Plan is a tool that is reviewed and updated on an ongoing basis and used at budget time to ensure that we maintain the current level of service that we have and help to mitigate any unexpected/surprise expenses.

We are currently working with an architect on design drawings, to do costing, for the possible refurbishment of the Nestor Falls Community Hall. If the project is approved, it will then go forward as part of the budgeting process.

The new digital signs are up and running. This will help advertise events and pass on information to the entire municipality. They are extra bright for those of us who have trouble seeing. As we learn the system we will continue to adjust them to find a happy medium.

The Solar Panels continue to generate power that helps to reduce our electricity costs, although we could have used more sun this winter.

Sun... not only for the panels, but for our own well-being. Chin up, spring is coming.
