We are finding an increase in garbage, dirty diapers, food waste, liquid residue and bottles/containers with caps/lids still fastened at our recycling collection depots.

Please ensure that no garbage, food or dirty containers are deposited for recycling. Please clean, wipe out and rinse well all food and liquid from containers. Also, please ensure that all bottle caps and container lids are removed (caps and lids of recyclable containers can be included with the items, just not fastened to them).

Garbage cannot be combined with recyclables. Garbage and dirty containers contaminate items rendering them non-recyclable.
