# Covid19 4<sup>th</sup> doses:

Folks ages 60 and over as well as First Nation, Inuit and Metis individuals and their non-Indigenous household members aged 19 and over are now eligible for a 4<sup>th</sup> dose (2<sup>nd</sup> booster) of the Covid19 vaccine.

Key things to note:

- Eligible individuals can now book an appointment for their 4<sup>th</sup> dose by using the Northwestern Health Unit's online booking system <u>https://clinicreservation.com/book-now/northwestern-health-unit</u>
- 4<sup>th</sup> doses are being offered to eligible individuals at a recommended interval of 5 months (140 days) after receiving their last booster; with exception, the interval can be reduced to 3 months (84 days) Anyone recovering from COVID should wait at least 3 months after infection to get their booster dose

Anyone with questions about eligibility can contact the Provincial Vaccine Contact Centre at 1-833-943-3900 (TTY for people who are deaf, hearing-impaired or speech-impaired: 1-866-797-0007), which is open seven days a week from 7am-7pm CST and capable of providing assistance in more than 300 languages.

#### 2022 Municipal Election Notice and Information

The next election will take place on October 24, 2022. The term of all offices to which the Municipal Elections Act applies is four years, beginning on November 15<sup>th</sup> in the year of a regular election. The Council for the Corporation of the Township of Sioux Narrows – Nestor Falls consists of five members; Mayor, 2 Councillors at Large, 1 Councillor for Ward 1 and 1 Councillor for Ward 2.

Voting Method

The Township of Sioux Narrows – Nestor Falls has used a mail-in-ballot since the 2000 Municipal and School Board Election. Council determines the method of voting and may consider other voting methods for future elections.

Nomination and Eligibility

Anyone wishing to run for office on Council in the 2022 Election must file a Nomination Paper with the Township commencing May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, and the deadline to submit nomination papers is on Nomination Day by 2:00PM, Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022. A filing fee in cash, certified cheque or money order is required with the submission of your Nomination Paper.

If you are interested in running as a candidate in the Municipal Election, it is recommended you review the Ministry of Municipal Affairs' 2022-2023 Candidates Guide which is posted on the Ministry's website, at: https://www.ontario.ca/document/ontario-municipal-councillors-guide

A person is entitled to be an elector at an election held in a local municipality if on Voting Day, he or she,

-resides in the local municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and -is a Canadian Citizen; and

-is at least 18 years old; and

-is not prohibited from voting under Section 17 Subsection 3 or otherwise by law.
