G. Black – gave report of the All Nations Health Partners (ANHP) meeting on December 16th, 2020. Renovations and administration activities at the Waterview Inn temporary housing facility continue, including the hiring of staff and implementation of food services. The space was ready for occupation December 21st, 2020. Isolation services are being held at a separate location for infection control. KCA, WNHAC and the Treaty 3 Police are participating in an 8-week pilot program for rapid result COVID-19 testing. Reported that the Northwestern Health Unit is establishing a committee for COVID-19 vaccination logistics. The committee would be comprised of agencies directly involved in vaccinations. Reported that, in compliance with the current provincial lockdown requirements, that the Sioux Narrows and Nestor Falls public libraries are operating by pick-up only. The next ANHP meetings will be January 13th, 2021.
