Delegations

J. O’Leary – Northwestern Health Unit (NWHU) Board Representative – reported that as of today, July 20th, 2021, there are three active Covid-19 cases in the NWHU catchment area. Vaccines are ongoing. Indicated that the mass clinics are starting to wrap up, but smaller setups will continue. To date, 95,732 vaccines have been administered by the NWHU. Our positivity rate is 1.06%. 76.4% have had a first dose and 59.8% have received second doses. 61% of 12-17 year olds are fully vaccinated. 95% of long term care residents are fully vaccinated. Approximately the same percentage of long term care home staff have been fully vaccinated.
