Reported that the Lake of the Woods District Hospital updated their visitor protocols, limiting visitation to one designated visitor for each patient. Gave report of the recent Vaccine Clinic in Sioux Narrows on June 12th, 2021; 110 vaccines were administered, most of which were second doses, but 18 were first doses, including 5 youth. Reported that roadside mowing of municipal roads began June 14th, 2021. A second cutting is planned for later in the summer.
