Reported that the Township is adopting a zero-tolerance approach to abusive, aggressive, threatening and violent language and behaviour. We are bringing light to this matter in response to a growing level of harassment of municipal staff and volunteers. This takes place in person, on the telephone, in writing, whether by letter, email or social media. No one should have to endure

Our Zero Tolerance approach, in the event of any of the aforementioned incidents, is to ask a person to leave, end a telephone call immediately and provide no response to written communications.
