AUXILIARY COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE CANADA OPERATION DARK SKIES—A FULL SCALE EXERCISE

On October 16th 2023, the Township of Sioux Narrows-Nestor Falls participated in a Canada Wide Communications Exercise from our Primary Emergency Operations Center radio room in Sioux Narrows.

The scenario was based on the upcoming total solar eclipse forecasted on April 8, 2024. Total solar eclipse events attract large volumes of visitors and media interest. The path of totality for this solar eclipse primarily covers the Great Lakes and the Niagara Peninsula. It is likely that a large volume of visitors will come to Niagara to view the event.

Some of the potential complications from this mass influx of people for a short and fixed duration that was highlighted in the full-scale exercise included:

- Impromptu/ad-hoc mass gatherings
- Planned and commercially organized mass gatherings
- Volume pressures and stoppages on critical infrastructures, including:
 - -Roads and Transportation
 - -Healthcare
 - -Communication systems
 - -Temporary disruptions to the continuity of government
 - -Capacity challenges for public safety and security

Due to the large volume of cell traffic that these events have experienced in the past this will likely happen in Ontario. Sioux Narrows role was to forward via our High Frequency Radio messages from the effected area and redirect them to the Provincial Emergency Operations Centre in Toronto. Our portion of the Exercise operated flawlessly. Two members of our communication team, Cathy Linton and Woody Linton carried out the six- hour operation.
