Did you know.....



The Treaty Three Police Service came into being in 2003. They have grown to be one of the larger Indigenous Police Services in the Province. Treaty Three Police officers attend the same training as Ontario Provincial Police Officers, meaning they attend the Ontario Police College for three months and the OPP's Provincial Police Academy for two months of post OPC training. The Treaty Three Police Service is able to enforce the same laws at the OPP or any other Municipal Police Service. Those laws include the Criminal Code, The Highway Traffic Act and other Provincial Statutes. The Treaty Three Police Service and the OPP support one another on a daily basis and attend calls for service together if needed and warranted.

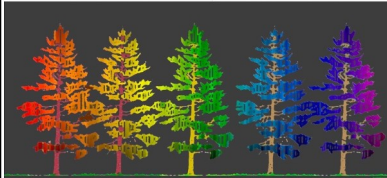
### Lake of the Woods Chapel United Church
